Used Oil Collection

PROTECT YOUR CHILDREN! DON'T PUT USED OIL ON THE STREET OR IN THE TRASH. Used motor oil is dangerous. Children should not breathe the fumes or get oil on their skin.

Because oil is dangerous, it is illegal to dispose of it in the trash, on the streets, on the ground, in streams, or in flood control channels. Take used motor oil to these certified collection centers:

They will dispose of the oil safely and legally -- to keep your children safe. And, they will pay you \$0.16 for each gallon of used oil! Kragen Auto Parts will accept your used oil filters. Call centers for hours of operation and quantities accepted.
