Rules, Regulations, and Sizes for Roll-Off Containers

NOTE: There may be other rules and regulations specific to the city in which your order is placed and you will be informed prior to confirmation of the order. If you have any questions, please call (888) 336-6100.

1. No dirt, rocks, concrete, cement, asphalt, blacktop, tile, bricks, gravel, sand, stucco, composition roofing, or any other heavy building or construction material is permitted in any container other than a 10-yard roll-off. No liquids, paints, hazardous materials, electronics, automobile parts, or animal carcasses are allowed in the containers. 2. All material must be level full to the rim of the container. Nothing should extend above the top or sides of the container. The maximum legal weight limit on any roll-off to be hauled is 10 tons.
3. We request one (1) day notification in advance to schedule a dump or bring-in. The container must be placed on a hard level surface.
4. The customer will be charged extra fees, (plus city fees if applicable), when the container cannot be hauled or is inaccessible as scheduled, including but not limited to (1) container over height, (2) container over weight, (3) container blocked, or (4) for the cancellation of a dispatched haul of a container. Charges may also apply to schedule changes if Athens Services does not receive adequate notification prior to the driver being dispatched to the location.
5. There is a seven (7) calendar day use limit on the container. The container will be automatically removed on the 7th day with the exception of Sunday, unless the customer notifies Athens Services in advance of the 7th day.
6. Additional days' rental fees are billed at our current per-day rate, plus any applicable city fees.
7. The prices of the 20 yard, 30 yard, and 40 yard containers includes up to 5 tons of material. The price of the 10 yard container includes up to 8 tons of material. Weight which exceeds the amount included is billed at our current additional per ton rate.
8. If any local city or municipal permit is required, it is the customer's responsibility to secure said permit. Additionally, there may be other rules and regulations specific to my City of which I will be informed when we speak on the telephone.
9. Storage Boxes. In addition to all other terms and conditions, the following applies to Storage Box rental. Storage of flammable, explosive, dangerous, or illegal materials is prohibited. Customer shall not sublet or assign the Storage Box nor store property owned by others without written consent of the Contractor. Failure of Customer to pay rental fees 30 days in advance will cause the Contractor to reclaim the Storage Box within seven (7) days written notice. Any property of the Customer found in the Storage Box reclaimed for non-payment will be disposed of at Contractor's discretion. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Agreement, in no event shall Contractor be liable to Customer for any damage, loss or personal injury to any person, property stored in, on, or about the Storage Box arising from any cause whatsoever, including, but not limited to, Contractor's active or passive acts, omissions, or negligence. Contractor does not provide insurance covering Customer's stored property and must notify the Contractor immediately of a change of address. Customer will indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Contractor from all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys fees that are hereafter made or brought by others as a result or arising out of Customer's use of the Storage Box. Terms of this Agreement may be changed by the Contractor without notice.
